Concurrent with Event 4 (28 ga.): Split 70% Team Buyer, 30% Team Shooters. Teams will be determined by shoot management, based on the combined average of the team members, making the teams as equal as possible. Calcutta bidding will be held after Saturday night dinner. Ties will divide payout.

Target minimums for State Team are:

500 12 ga., 500 20 ga., 500 28 ga., 500 410 bore, 300 Doubles 300 of each gauge must be shot in New Mexico.

Award presentations, for DBLS, 12, 20, 28, 410, HOA, and HAA, will follow the shoot-offs on Sunday.

This shoot is sanctioned by NSSA, whose rules will govern. All New Mexico residents must be members of NMSSA. NMSSA reserves the right to change the program at any time without recourse or protest.

Purses: If a shooter finishes as an event Champion or Runner Up in the preliminary event or events 1 - 5, that shooter will be awarded the higher purse between the event purse and class purse in the class in which he shoots. In events 6 and 8, the purses will remain with the title due to the added money.

Ties and Shoot-offs: All ties will be shot off, no long runs. Doubles at stations 3 – 4 – 5 for all events except HOA Champion. All shoot-offs, miss and out by station. NSSA rules will govern.

Ties for HOA Champion will be shot-off by shooting a regular round of skeet, with the high score winning. If no winner has been determined after one round of regular skeet, the shoot-off will proceed to doubles at 3 – 4 – 5.

Referees: Referees will be paid \$0.07 per target. Anyone interested in being a referee, contact John Moen (575) 644-3936

Protests: Referee's decision on all questions of fact will be final. All other protests referred to the Protest Committee.

Liability: Spectators and contestants assume all risks of accidents.

Ammunition: No ammunition will be sold at the club during the shoot. No proofs will be provided.

Practice Rounds: \$5.00 each. Club will be open for practice beginning at 4:30 to dusk Thursday afternoon and at 8:00 am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Meals: Lunch and drinks are included Saturday and Sunday for all competitors.
